World Federation's United Nations logo links the United Nations activities and programs with the basis of all that motivates christians to serve Christ and the world.

Within the 'U' of United Nations is a circle which is a symbol of the world, and the empty cross is superimposed over the world as a sign of God's commitment and involvement with humankind, through the redemptive actions of Jesus Christ.

The 'U' and the 'N' are linked together as a symbol of hope for a united effort by people of good will to improve the life and living conditions of the women, men and children of this world. The women's symbol completes this thought-provoking logo.











Constitution of the Aborto Federation of Methodist Abomen

Attlicte I- Manie - This organization shall be known as the 20orts Feberation of

Article IV - Membership - All national groups organized in accordance with Articles II and III are eligible for membership in the Aborto Feberation of Methodist Abomen. The Basis and Aim must be quoted in full in the Constitution of all national organizations.

Article V-International Council - There shall be a promotional and advisory body known as the International Council of the World Tedevalion of Methodist Woman. The membership of the Council shall consist of one official correspondent from each affiliated country on the basis of one member for each one hundred thousand or less members of the national organization. Each unit shall operate under its own constitution and by-laws. The Council shall act as a unitying and correlating agency for the exchange of plans. programs and policies and for the promotion of projects mutually decepted by the countries represented.

Article M- Office's - Chere shall be a President, a First Dice President, Creasurer and Secretary elected by the Council. There shall also be an additional Rice President elected by each jurisdiction and Central Conference within the Methodist Church. Representation on a similar basis will be accorded national groups of woman of other Methodist communions.

The above constitutes the Executive Committee of the Council. The Executive Committee and the Official Correspondents mentioned in Arlicle Shall constitute the voting

boby at the quabrennial meetings.

Article MI- Meetings - The Council shall meet once in four years at the time and place of the General Conference of The Methodist Church.

Athile VIII - finance - The Council shall be maintained by special gifts, bequests and bevices and by voluntary contributions from each affiliated group.

Article IX- Change of Constitution - This Constitution may be amended at any quadrennial meeting of the voting body of the Council by a three - fourths vote of those present and voting, notice of the proposed change having been given in writing one year in advance of the meeting.

Constitution of the Quorld Federation of Methodist Women

Arlife I- Manie- This organization shall be known as the 20orto Federation of onethodist 200men.

Article II-Basis - The World Federation of Methodist Women is a Fellowship of such organized groups as will accept Jesus Christ as the revelation of God and the Savier of mankind and will affirm their purpose, "To know Him and to make Him known;
