Goal 5 - Maternal refers to who? - WOMEN




Goal 6 - Who are the most infected with HIV/AIDS and STIs - WOMEN

Goal 7 - Who are engaged mostly in unsafe environmental conditions - especially in third world countries? - WOMEN (daily use of charcoal and/ or firewood)







#### THE MDGs AND THE CHURCH

- Agricultural produce processing (jam making, local fruit juices, hot pepper sauce)
- Charcoal production
- Small scale animal husbandry (piggery, poultry, sheep rearing)
- Plant and vegetable Nurseries

How Do We Relate These Goals To Women In The Church?



As Christian women we can provide hope for the poor (Isaiah 41 v17, Matthew 19 v2)

How Do We Relate These Goals To Women In The Church?



 Train women on income generating schemes - soap making, tie and dye, bead making, preservation of local foodstuffs, sewing etc.

How Do WE Relate These Goals To Women In The Church?



As Christian women, we can provide hope for Learners (Colossians 2 v2-3)

- Advocate for children to get uninterrupted education
- Encourage mothers to be educated (so as to understand the educational needs of the child)



How Do We Relate These Goals To Women In The Church?



As Christian women, we can provide hope for Equality (Galatians 3v27-28)

- Women can bring up their boys and girls equally and make them treat each other with respect
- Sunday school and fellowships meetings are responsible to provide leadership training for both sexes
- Women can help other women and girls discover their self worth (uplift their self confidence and esteem)



How Do We Relate These Goals To Women In The Church?



As Christian women, we can provide hope for the children (Matthew 18 v1-5)

- Provide counseling for young girls on the dangers of teenage pregnancy
- Raise awareness on the problems of child birth faced by mothers and young girls



How Do We Relate These Goals To Women In The Church?



As Christian women, we can provide hope for mothers (Mark 7 v24-30)

- Family life education and life skills
- Advocate for creche facilities at workplaces
- Advocate for exclusive breast feeding for the first six months of the baby's life



How Do We Relate These Goals To Women In The Church?



As Christian women, we can provide hope for wholeness (Matthew 12 v15)

- Be more informed about HIV and AIDS
- Promote the welfare of People living with HIV and AIDS
- Campaign against stigma and discrimination of infected persons
- Visit regularly the victims and orphans
- Conduct counseling for sufferers and their families



How Do We Relate These Goals To Women In The Church?



As Christian women, we can provide hope for wholeness (Matthew 12 v15)

- Set up income generating activities for victims
- Educate others on malaria, TB and other diseases
- Engage in the distribution of bed nets to families



How Do We Relate These Goals To Women In The Church?



As Christian women, we can provide hope for creation (Isaiah 41 v17-20; Matthew 28v 18)

- Women can encourage families to recycle
- Use clean water at all times
- Determine ways of using new sources of energy and fuel
- Educate families on the importance of a sustainable environment

Taking into consideration all of these issues, West Africa's women's race to the MDGs is still on. We may not get there this time, BUT WE WILL SURELY GET THERE IN GOD'S TIME.
