Hunger and malnutrition are barriers to sustainable development because hungry people are less productive, more prone to disease and less able to improve their livelihoods.

SDG 4: Quality Education

In addition to free primary and secondary schooling for all boys and girls by 2030, the aim is to provide equal access to affordable vocational training, eliminating gender and wealth disparities to achieve a universal access to quality higher education.

7. DISCUSSION POINT

ARE WE DOING ENOUGH TO ENABLE THE GIRL CHILD TO ATTEND SCHOOL? IF SO, SHARE OWN EXPERIENCES?
